

Saffronart to Open New Gallery Space in Delhi with Krishen Khanna Exhibition

- State-of-the-art gallery space of 3,000 sq. ft. at The Claridges, New Delhi
- Opening to be inaugurated by Indian modernist Krishen Khanna
- 24 recent works by Khanna to be exhibited at the opening
- New gallery space extends Saffronart's efforts to support the arts through talks and events with partner galleries

Mumbai, 25 October 2016: In November, Saffronart is opening a state-of-the-art gallery space at The Claridges, located in the heart of Lutyens' Delhi and famed for its old-world charm. The swanky 3,000 square foot gallery space is the finest of its kind in the centre of the capital. It will be home to exhibition and auction previews, as well as viewings, talks, and partner events with other leading galleries.

The new space will be inaugurated by Krishen Khanna, with an exhibition of recent works through 13 November. One of India's leading and last surviving modernists, Krishen Khanna was born in 1925. His work focuses on the human figure, specifically those who are overlooked or ignored in society. Band musicians, waiters at roadside tea-stalls or *dhabas*, and labourers sleeping beneath trucks gain dignity in his work. He adds renewed vigour to the themes that he visited throughout his career in twenty-four new monochromatic works, to be displayed at Saffronart Delhi.

CEO Hugo Weihe says, "We are proud to inaugurate our versatile, state-of-the-art gallery space with an exhibition of works by Krishen Khanna. Our gallery's location in the heart of the capital makes it easily accessible, allowing us to hold exhibitions, previews, talks and other art initiatives. Additionally, the gallery space will be used to collaborate with artists and partner galleries in Delhi, extending Saffronart's continued efforts to support the arts."

The gallery opening will be followed by a series of talks on art. Among the events planned over the next two months is an exhibition of works by Ram Kumar in December 2016.
